The health and safety of you members of our congregation, and that of our Staff Members, are our top priority. We welcome you to attend Unity of Austin Sunday Services. To express God's love by holding regard for everyone's safety we require the following:

Low Risk Level

For those fully vaccinated:

- No symptoms of illness
- Upon entry show the Usher your up-to-date proof of vaccination and valid ID
- Sign-up on list - name and phone or email for notification of covid exposure should that occur
- Masks optional (N95 mask)
- Maintain 3 feet of social distance

For those NOT fully vaccinated:

- No symptoms of illness
- Sign name and phone or email for notification of covid exposure should that occur
- Masks required (N95 mask)
- Maintain 3 feet of social distance

Medium Risk Level

For those fully vaccinated:

- No symptoms of illness
- Upon entry show the Usher your up-to-date proof of vaccination and ID
- Sign-up on list - name and phone or email for notification of covid exposure should that occur
- Masks required (N95 mask)
- Maintain 3 feet of social distance

For those *NOT* fully vaccinated:

- No symptoms of illness
- Sign name and phone or email for notification of covid exposure should that occur
- Masks required (N95 mask)
- Maintain 3 feet of social distance

GUIDELINES FOR CHILDREN AND TEENS

Children and teens are welcome in the Sanctuary with their parents or guardians. We will notify you when Youth and Family Ministry classes are open.

Children's Safety Guidelines are the same as Adult Guidelines above, with these exceptions -

- Mask optional for children under age 5 in both Low and Medium Risk Levels
- No covid test required for unvaccinated children - masks are required for children over 5 years if unvaccinated.
- When YFM Classes resume, all YFM Teachers will wear effective masks (N95)
